Well, I'm starting out a new week and things seemed to be getting a little more routine.

We had an awful rain & wind storm yesterday. It started sprinkling just before we got out of church. Then about 2 o'clock it really came down. It is awfully cold today. We notice that because it has been so awfully warm.

I don't know whether I have ever mentioned Mrs. Jones to you or not but she died last week & Paul is trying to get a group together to sing for her funeral, so Ma and I don't know for sure who else, are going over to P.P. Geneva's house to practice tonight.

We have a house meeting tonight after supper & I'm just hoping Ma doesn't come after me before it is over.

It seems like I must be taking an expensive schedule this year. Besides the regular \$6 fees, I have to pay \$4 for Bowling Club, \$5 for ~~the~~ Microbiology supplies, \$3 for a uniform for foods lab. I am paying half of Mary Lou's

uniform because they cost six dollars a
piece. my books cost about \$15. I used
the cash I had for that. I also had to buy a
recipe file for foods class

Most of my course this term are lecture
courses. History is a course called "The U. S.
and its place in world affairs since 1900," which
